## About Signs of the Times

The scriptures declare that God, the God of Israel, the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob, chose for Himself only one nation of undeserving people; declared them to be His people and elected them to be His bride. By His Word alone, they were born into His kingdom and He set about teaching them how to live the kingdom life whilst waiting for the redemption of the purchased possession when Messiah would come for them. But the plan would have been fine except for one very important aspect: God gave his elect the freewill to choose to disobey Him – the same freewill He gave to Adam and Eve.

Over a quite short period of the history of the congregation of Israel, there were many times when God used leaders such as Moses, Joshua and the Judges, to correct the thinking of His children. Later, in times of crisis, prophets were raised up to warn of deception and enemy attack which came about when the people of God had fallen away from the truth and were worshipping the false gods of the pagans alongside the true God. The children of God clearly were blind to their apostasy and were unable to see the error in their practices.

If consideration is given to why this was so, it may be observed that their spiritual adultery was the cause of that blindness. Their blindness necessitated sending obedient prophets who, in the face of much blindness, deafness and determined rejection, faithfully proclaimed that God's word was the only true way.

As a result of the mixture of truth and error, Israel and then Judah were allowed by God to fall into the hands of their enemies as a warning to them to mend their ways. They did not listen, however, and finally God brought on them the ultimate punishment that has been ongoing for nearly 2000 years: He thrust them into the hands of the Gentiles until He considered it time to bring about their restoration to their land.

Many of the children of God were blind to the day of their Lord's first appearing because they preferred the half-truths of paganism to the whole truth of scripture. They are prophetically typical of today's assemblies, which can just as easily fail to appreciate the warnings and fail to see the signs of the Lord's appearing. Our blindness and deafness are just as pervasive and just as likely to overcome us, as that of the chosen ones of the Older Covenant. Half-truths of paganism are still being upheld in many places in preference to, or by adding to, scripture; the warning of Jesus Himself, "Watch out no-one deceives you", is steadily being ignored.

Before the second appearing of Jesus, scripture warns us of many days of STRONG DELUSION when the Man of Sin will be able to sit in the Temple of God declaring that he is God. For this to occur, the Biblical warning of a falling away from truth will have to be fulfilled. Biblical prophecy shows us that there will be adultery with the world, leading to an entry into the Temple of that which is pagan. That entry has already begun.

Our ministry, therefore, is to proclaim the truth of scripture; not as a philosophy among many, but as the living Word of God for all who have the Holy Spirit to illuminate them. Scripture is the benchmark by which all things must be judged, and it is the Holy Spirit who actively seeks to convict us of our sins, bring us to repentance and lead us closer to Jesus. He is the only One who can heal us and set us free from bondage to sin. But He will only do so if we will submit to the Word alone: God does not use paganism.

In this ministry, therefore, we proclaim the prophecies that point to the events surrounding the Second Coming and we consider ways in which the leaven of paganism is mixed with the bread of life. Our intention is always to warn of error and to lead the body of Christ back to the truth of scripture.

May the One and only true God, revealed in the Tri-unity of Father, Son and Holy Spirit, whose One Name is Yeshua Ha'Natzri Ve'Melech Ha'Yehudim, the only Name by which men may be saved, bless you as you read and hear what is spoken to you through this ministry; may He make His face to shine upon you and may He give you His peace.
